

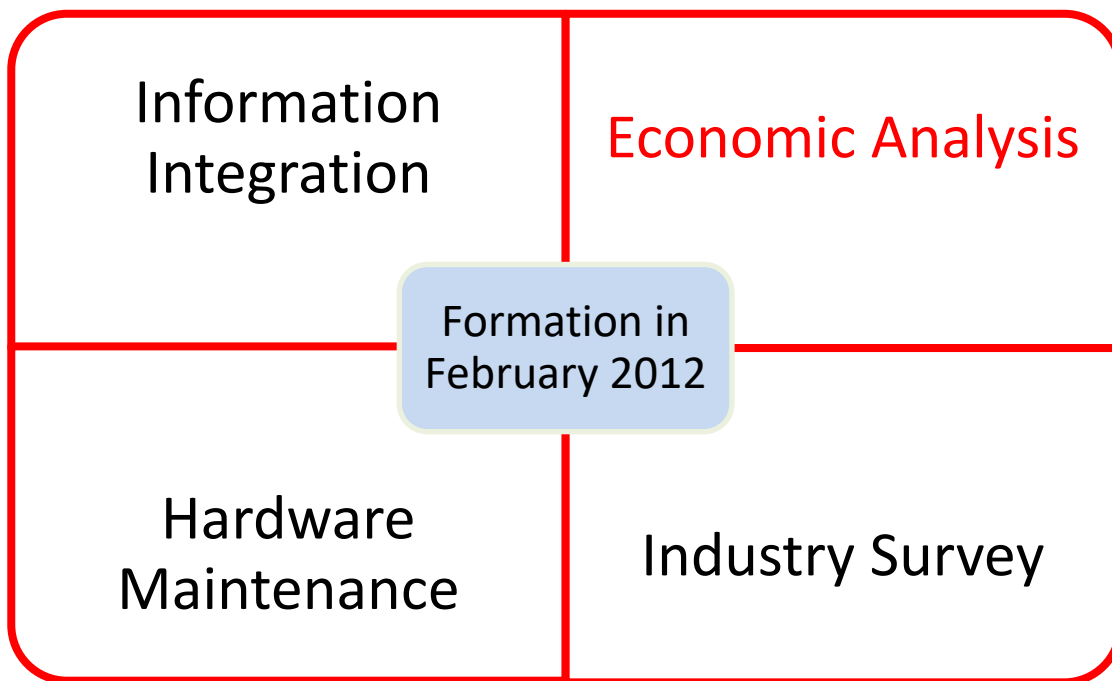

- Provide economic analysis advice
 - Analyze the antitrust case with economic thinking
 - Focus on relevant cases to the market definition 、 unilateral effect 、 restricting competition effect etc.

What the Economic Analysis Section Do

- Finish Economic research Report
 - Study some important issues and complete report
 - Market Definition :
the methods and examples of market definition
 - Merger : UPP method
 - Cartel : the structural screen and detection of cartel
 - other : resale price maintenance 、 Franchise
